6. Can you name the organisation that built the platform at the lodge/lake? (*Clue: look down!*).

7. Give the names of 2 wildflower species found on site that will encourage butterflies. (*Clue: Spodden Valley notice board 2*).

8. What is the name of the river which runs through Spodden Valley?

9. What is the name of the prolific weed with the pink flower you'll see along the river edges in summer? (*Clue:* )

10. What is the animal on the logo of The Wildlife Trusts?

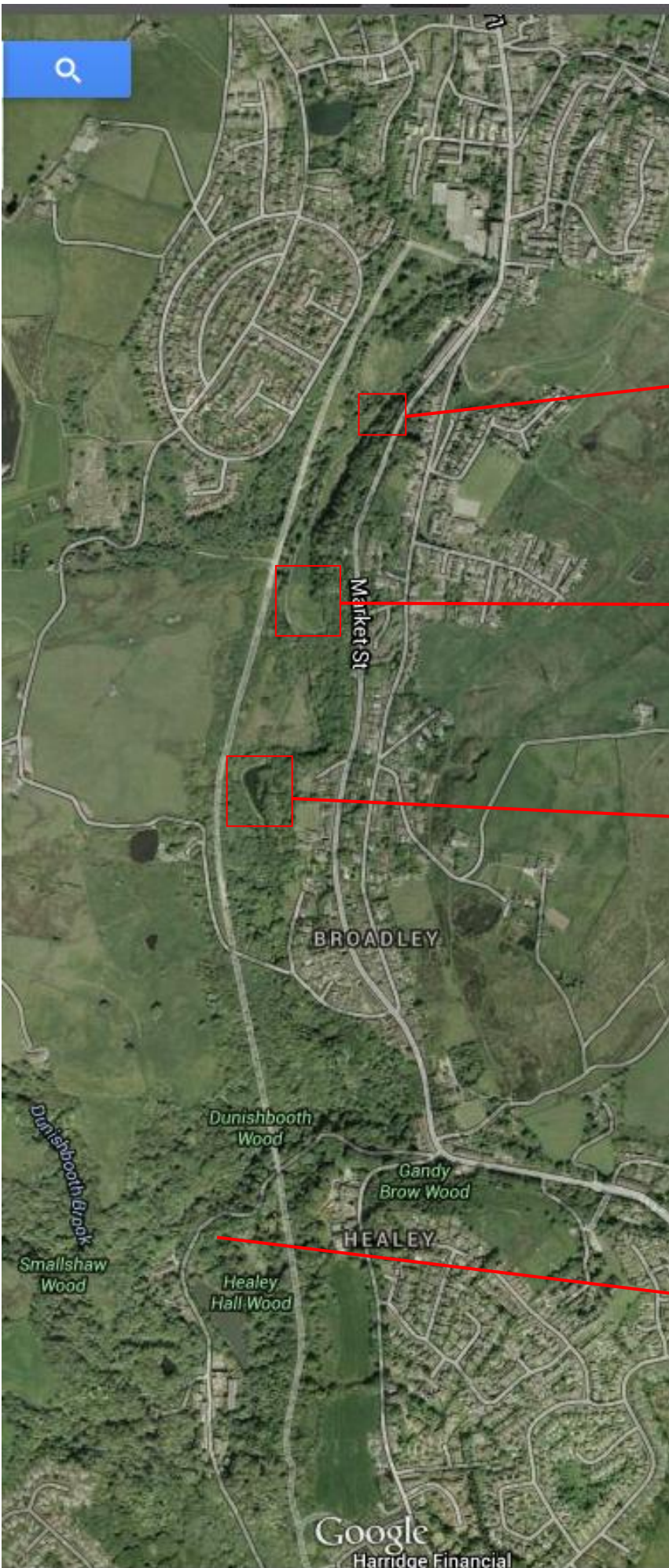
